Donaldson Class have had a great week and all the children have been really settled and focused. They are really enjoying their learning and I have seen some excellent Maths work with the children exploring the number 1.

Dahl Class have started their first project of the year: Are there still discoveries to be made? They have been developing their historical enquiry skills by producing an Egyptian timeline. The children have also been exploring speech marks in English with some excellent results.

Rowling Class have been diving deeper in place value this week, honing their skills ready to apply them to solve problems. They have also developed their Map reading skills by locating the 7 Natural Wonders of the World on a World Map to begin their new project.

As discussed in the meeting, this style of homework is designed to engage the children and for them to take ownership of their own learning as well as complete certain tasks as a family.
