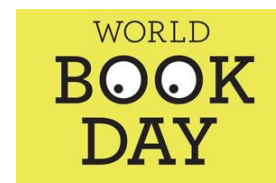


Term Dates

Our igloo is coming along nicely but we could still do with some more plastic milk bottles (2 pint or bigger), thank you.

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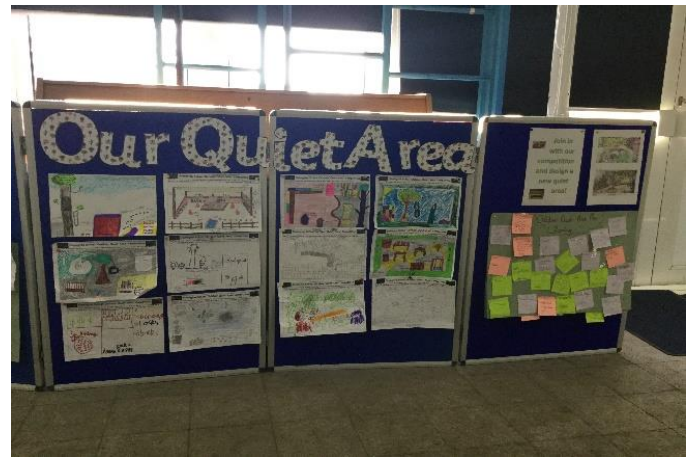


Breakfast and After school club
