### In the classrooms:

**Donaldson class** have been exploring a new whole class text this week – Alfie the Burglar. When I was in class on Wednesday, the children were having an excellent discussion about one of the pictures of Alfie and a fox. Some quality language was being used to describe each of the characters. They have also been planning their diary based on the text, ‘The Polar Bear Son’.

**Dahl class** have been out in the playgrouynd doing an intreactive ‘Rounding’ sessions in Maths. The children said they learnt a lot and really enjoyed it. Lego has also been the theme this week with two fantastic models coming in from home to support their new project, ‘Is this the greatest show?’ with some excellent poems being produced.

**Rowling class** have been learning all about Earthquakes and how they happen. They now know about S,L and P waves plus the reasons behind Earthquakes occuring. The children have also written an eyewitness account of being in an Earthquake and descriptive writing of an Earthquake scene. The writing has been of a high quality and I hope this continues for the rest of the year.
