Donaldson: I've had the pleasure of teaching the children today. They have been a great bunch, working on money during Maths, trying hard with their spellings and we had an excellent discussion this afternoon around the whole class reading book, 'The Burglar's Breakfast'


Friends of Sinnington School (FOSS)
