It has been a busy second full week in school. Walking around school this week, I have been pleased to see that all the children have come back to school with an excellent work ethic.

On Thursday, we were fortunate to have a visit from our local Maths Hub. The government funded Hub is supporting school and staff to become trained in delivering Maths Mastery across school and ultimately develop the mathematical abilities of all our children. Josh Greening, from the Hub, commented on how well the children presented their work, their excellent work ethic and how they support one another with their learning. It is always nice to have visitors make such lovely comments and it reflects the hard work that all the children and staff put in on a daily basis.



In the classrooms:

Donaldson Class are now settled in their classroom and they are really enjoying the continuous provision that is available and changed daily to match every child's needs and interests. The children, in Maths, have been mastering the number two and looking at all the relationships and patterns that are linked to the number. The children are really enjoying the Mastery approach and there is a lot of mathematical discussion on a daily basis.

Dahl Class have also been working hard on their Maths exploring and digging deeper into addition and applying their skills to solve addition problems. A number of children have also started to bring in lego models of Egyptian artefacts and pyramids as part of their Project homework – the models have been fantastic and very detailed.

Rowling Class have been challenged in their Maths this week, focusing on Place Value. The children have been developing their skills further and have mastered rounding numbers this week up to 1,000,000. In Science, they have been exploring how to categorise animals by using their specific characteristics.
