Donaldson Class:

On my visits to class this week, I have seen the children work well together discussing the properties of 2D shapes in Maths including the number of sides and vertices. The children are also engrossed in their whole class text the Jolly Postman; reading the postcard that has been sent to the Giant. The children are now working hard on producing their own postcard that they will be sending to another fairy tale character – Jack.

Dahl Class:

Popping into Dahl class this week, I have seen the children begin to form some excellent arguments against logging and deforestation as part of their project 'Why do we need the rainforest?'. The children are now in the process of creating an argumentative written piece. It was great to see their passion about why we need trees and that we should do everything we can to stop logging and preserve our natural habitats.

Rowling Class:

All the children have been learning about everything to do with fractions. It has led to plenty of discussion and reasoning as well as the children applying their mathematical knowledge. The WW1 project is ongoing with the children producing some fantastic descriptive writing on a battlefield image using figurative language. It is great to see their enthusiasm for the project – next week it is our Trench Day (information will be sent via BROMCOM).
