#### In the Classrooms:

Donaldson Class have been further developing their Maths skills using the mastery approach to explore the number 3. The children have now begun their Phonics following our brand new ReadWriteInc scheme. The scheme is designed for the children to immerse themselves in the sounds and to apply and recognise these both in their Reading and Writing. The children are really enjoying their new project, 'What makes me special?' and looking at where they live using maps focusing on their house and street. Dahl Class are discovering Egypt in more detail specifically the River Nile. They have been studying why the Nile is important to the Eyptian people both now and in the past. In Maths, the children are developing their skills in addition and exploring all the facts related to addition in a mastery approach. Rowling Class have been working very hard in Maths this week and all the children are getting to grips with the Mastery approach. They have immersed themselves into place value and they are now moving next week onto the 4 operations. The children have also been refining their map skills locating mountain ranges of the World using an atlas and next week they will be exploring Mount Everest as part of our Natural Wonders of the World project.
