In the classrooms:

Donaldson Class: The children have begun to learn facts about and how to tell the time with a number of practical sessions in Maths. They have also been working hard on their project – The Great Fire of London and the children have been introduced to their new class book, 'Vlad and the Great Fire of London'. This is a book about a flea that witnesses the fire and the children have now started to use the language and pictures in the book to create and plan pieces of writing.

Dahl Class have been multiplying 4, 5 and 6 digit numbers with decimals by 10 and 100. I witnessed this week some excellent discussions where the children were really engaged and enjoying their Maths. They have also begun to write a radio script in English based on Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. The children were creating questions for reporters who were going to ask them to Charlie after he had found his Golden Ticket.

Rowling Class have been working hard on Ratio (Year 6) and Multiplication and Division (Year 5) in Maths this week. In English, the children have started their new project, 'Can we live on the Moon?' with a research task on two famous people: Neil Armstrong and Yuri Gagarin. The children have been researching information and gathering facts from around the classroom and they are now in the process of planning a Biography on one of these famous space explorers.
