**It has been another busy week in school with two trips and a range of new learning. The children have worked very hard, as always, with an eye on the Easter Holidays in a weeks time.**

### Around the classrooms:

**Donaldson Class** have been busy working on their project: The Great Fire of London this week. They have begun to build models for their street scene (more boxes required please!) ready for an exciting finale next week. The children are now exploring their book: Vlad and The Great Fire of London, using Vlad the flea as their inspiration to write diary entries about the sights and sounds of the City of London through the eyes of the flea as the fire besieges the city.

**Dahl Class** had an amazing trip to the museum: York's Chocolate Story. The children developed their knowledge of chocolate, the Mayans and also investigated, hands-on, how chocolate was made. A few treats even came back into school! The children are now using their experience to create their own information leaflet about the museum.

**Rowling Class** were also on a trip this week to the Life Centre in Newcastle. The trip really developed the children's knowledge about the moon and its' history. There was an enormous interactive moon, a planetarium where the children learnt new facts and an interactive workshop where the children explored life as an astronaut. The children are now focused on their new project and it has been a great way in which to ignite their learning.

The two trips that the children have been on this week have been invaluable experiences for every single child and so have the previous trips and those that are planned for the Summer term. These trips are only possible through the fundraising activities of FOSS who help support the trips by funding transport. A huge thank you to FOSS for their continued support.

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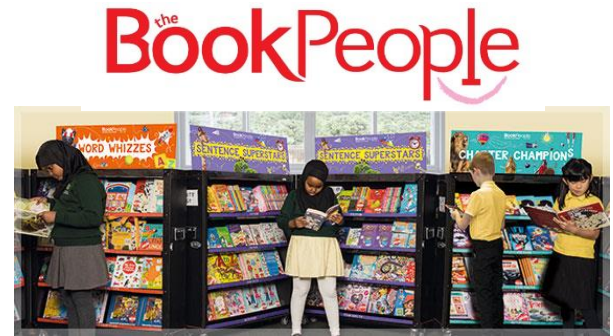
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## The Book Fair
