Year 5 and 6 Football at Ryedale School - Our mixed team of boys and girls did really well, playing with great team spirit, they were a credit to the school.



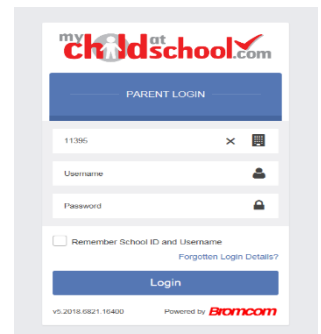
Conkers Competition
